

The Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023: Compliance and Notice

Data Fiduciary:

- Central Waqf Council is a statutory body under the Waqf Act and may be treated as Data Fiduciary under the Act, 2023

Data Principal

- Usually the waqf institution applying for loan under Shahari Waqf Sampatti Vikas Yojna (SWSVY) shall have to share their information and data, out of which some may be personal in nature for the mutawalli or the waqf institutions and are treated as data of the WAQF as Data Principal

Lawful purposes & Data Minimization

- Data/ Information are intended from the Mutawalli/managing committee/waqf boards, with their prior consent and approval only for the lawful purposes and functions and for the services provided in Central Waqf Council (CWC) to the waqf institutions and its mutawalli or beneficiaries of such waqfs.
- Data so obtained, is used for the specific purposes for which it is obtained like sanction and release of loan to the urban waqf properties under Shahari Waqf Sampatti Vikas Yojna (SWSVY) for the purposes of construction and development on the waqf properties and further safe guarding them against encroachment in future.
- For keeping data of welfare activities addressed to the weaker section of the society which is ultimately executed by the waqfs with the prompt aid and assistance of the Central Government and its agencies i.e. CWC under SWSVY.
- The documents containing data/information are returned to the mutawalli/waqf institution either directly under intimation to the guarantor Waqf Board only or through waqf boards.

Data retention and safeguards mechanism in CWC (Development Section)

- The data collected are retained with safeguards in the concerned **development section** of the Central Waqf Council, the waqf have the access to their data for all lawful purposes including amendment and withdrawal etc following the guidelines of the Scheme and related policies of the Govt. (Ministry) and CWC may be functioning as its agencies .

Other Compliance of the other compliance of the Act, 2023

- e-office functioning, role-based access to files, and government mails are operating in CWC.
- Income tax return and related activities are accomplished through e-filing mode only.
- Digilocker facilities for the project and other files are to be available to future projects

Citizen Right to access data available in CWC

- The information is provided in terms of the Right to Information Act, 2005 and other extant rules of the government.
- Contract and agreements with vendors and service providers are made and executed through Government portal (GEM) only based on the policies and guidelines of the central government (DopTs) issued time to time.
